

Below is a summary of outcomes, by domain, for which Vermont's *overall* state average was either notably higher (more than 5% above) or notably lower (more than 5% below) than the NCI-AD Average. **Please note** that “higher” does not necessarily mean a better outcome and “lower” does not necessarily mean worse; the term simply indicates whether the difference fell above or below NCI-AD Average for that item. These highlights do not include demographic information from Section I of the 2017-18 NCI-AD National Report.
